These events draw thousands of people to interact with major motorcycle manufacturers and see the new models. If you're looking for a new bike, IMS is where you can sit on many models back-to-back to see which one fits you well. PLUS, there are plenty of opportunities to jump on the bikes for a test drive – even if you don't have a license.

Don't miss the vintage, classic and retro-style motorcycles on display from bike clubs across the country. Another "must-see" attraction is the J&P Cycles Ultimate Builder Custom Bike Show. It is the world's largest motorcycle builder competition, featuring more than 300 motorcycles and \$100,000 in cash and prizes. Professional and amateur builders compete at local shows for their chance to move-on to the Championship Round in Chicago.

And it's not just about motorcycles. You can boost your knowledge about parts, gear and accessories. Numerous manufacturers of all kinds are on hand to show you tires, batteries, windshields, helmets, and other riding gear. You can find pretty much any patch you can imagine. Several event promoters, such as Laconia and Americade, have booths to try and draw attendees. So do a number of motorcycle clubs. The funniest thing I saw at the last show was the Christian Motorcyclists Association and the Hell's Angels practically a booth away from each other.
